Jubilee Year 2025

Pope Francis has proclaimed 2025 to be the Ordinary Jubilee or Holy Year 2025, The Bull of Indiction was given at St. John Lateran basilica on the solemnity of the Ascension.

Pope Francis writes, "For all of us, may the Jubilee be an opportunity to be renewed in hope. God's word helps us to find reason for that hope. Taking it as our guide, let us return to the message that the Apostle Paul wished to communicate to the Christians of Rome"

"Hope does not disappoint" (Rm 5:5). ... Hope is also the central message of the coming Jubilee that, in accordance with an ancient tradition, the Pope proclaims every twenty-five years. My thoughts turn to all those pilgrims of hope who travel to Rome in order to experience the Holy Year and to all those others who, though unable to visit the City of the Apostles Peter and Paul, will celebrate it in their local Churches. For everyone, may the Jubilee be a moment of genuine, personal encounter with the Lord Jesus, the "door" (cf. Jn 10:7, 9) of our salvation, whom the Church is charged to proclaim always, everywhere and to all as "our hope" (1 Tm 1:1) (Pope Francis, *Spes non confundit*, 1).
